Re: Safety Data Sheet - CompoFlex, DiaFlex, DiaThin & DiaTrim

With regards to a Safety Data Sheet (SDS) from VH Technologies LTD for the above mentioned products, please read the following information:

A Safety Data Sheet (SDS) has not been prepared for these product(s) because they meet the definition of "articles" as defined by the United States Department of Labor, Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA), and is a "manufactured article" as defined by the Canadian Hazardous Products Act (R.S.C., 1985, c. H-3). Due to this, the above products are exempt from the requirement for an SDS.

US Federal OSHA (29 CFR 1910.1200(b)(6)(v) defines an article "article" as:

Article means a manufactured item other than a fluid or particle: (i) which is formed to be a specific design or shape during manufacture; (ii) which has end use function(s) dependent in part or in whole upon its shape or design during end use; and (iii) which under normal conditions of use does not release more than very small quantities, e.g., minute or trace amounts of a hazardous chemical (as determined under paragraph (d) of this section), and does not pose a physical hazard or health risk to employees or others.

The Canadian Federal Hazardous Product Act (R.S.C., 1985, c. H-3), Part II, Paragraph 12(i) and (j) exempt from the application of this manufactured articles and devices listed in Schedule 1.

2 – Interpretation

"Manufactured article"/"article manufacture`"

"manufactured article" means any article that is formed to a specific design or shape during manufacture, the intended use of which when in that form is dependent in whole or in part on its shape or design, and that, under normal conditions of use, will not release or otherwise cause a person(s) to be exposed to a controlled product;

(3) Any cosmetic, drug, food or device, as defined in section 2 of the Food and Drugs Act
